Kansuke Yamamoto

- 1914 Born in Nagoya, Aichi, Japan
- 1929 Graduated from Nagoya City Commercial School
Enrolled in French Literature department at Meiji University (quit after approximately one year)
- 1931 Founded "Dokuritsu Shashin Kenkyukai" (Independent Photography Research Association) with Mitsuya Okonogi and others in Nagoya
- 1933 Became a member of "Kogei" (Crafts) magazine group, published by Soetsu Yanagi
- 1935 Established "A.B.C. Photo Club" with Mitsuya Okonogi
- 1938 Formed a photo group "Seidosha" (Blue Admiration Society) with Motoo Yoshitake and others
- 1939 Joined "Nagoya Photo Avant-Garde", cofounded by Yoshio Shimosato and Chiryu Yamanaka ("Nagoya Photo Avant-Garde" dissolved in 1941 after changing its name to "Nagoya Shashin Bunka Kyokai" (Nagoya Photography Culture Association) (left the group by the end of 1939)
Joined the avant-garde poetry group "VOU", formed by Katsue Kitasono (dissolved in 1978)
- 1947 Formed the photography group "VIVI" with Keiichiro Goto, Minayoshi Takada and Yoshifumi Hattori
- 1949 Joined photography section of Bijutsu Bunka Kyokai (Fine Art and Culture Association), an association of Surrealist artists (left the group in 1954)
- 1953 Founded photo group "Mado" (Window) with Keiichiro Goto, Minayoshi Takada, Tatsuo Kondo and others
- 1955 Formed the group "Honooo" (Flame) with Keiichiro Goto, Tatsuo Kondo, and Katsuhiko Okazaki, and Kaoru Utsumi
- 1956 Formed the experimental group "ESPACE" with Roger van hecke, Kinichiro Kato, and Ichiro Hirose
Founded "Nihon Shukanshugi Shashin Renmei" (Japanese Subjectivism Photography Federation)
- 1958 Participated in formation of "Zenei Shijin Kyokai" (Avant-Garde Poetry Association)
Formed "Arukishine (8mm)", a group dedicated to making short films with Katsue Kitasono, Kon Ichikawa, Yusaku Kamekura, Masanari Murai, Jiro Asatsuma, Takachiyo Uemura, and others
- 1963 Formed the group "NAGOYA 5"
- 1966 Instructional adviser for Chubu Gakusei Shashin Renmei (Chubu Photography Federation of Students)
- 1987 Passed away
